

## ABOUT THE DEHUKAM POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

One of the priorities of the "Turkish National Maritime Research Strategy (TUDAS) Document," approved by the Council of Ministers, is the improving and strengthening of research and education capacity in the field of the sea and maritime law. Ankara University National Center for the Sea and Maritime Law (DEHUKAM) as a research center was founded following the recommendation by the Republic of Turkey Ministry of Foreign Affairs and has gained the legal entity status and become a national center by the decision of the Research Infrastructures Commission.

With the aim of training qualified persons to work and do research in the area of the sea and maritime law, DEHUKAM, apart from organizing of participating in international symposiums, workshops and courses, and from collaborating with other key institutions in the World, runs DEHUKAM LLM (with or without thesis) / PhD Programmes in the Sea and Maritime Law as were approved by the Turkish Council of Higher Education.

Lectures to be taken during the programme, comprises almost twenty lectures focused in the following three major units:

- (i) Law of the Sea,
- (ii) Maritime Law,
- (iii) Maritime Security Law.





DEHUKAM's one of the aims is to offer a program that will, among other things, enable its attendees to specialize in maritime security law in the benefit of not only law graduates but also coast guards, navy and port security personal.

There are currently 15 foreign lecturers who are leading practitioners, prominent academics, specialists in their respective fields, and renowned international experts.



The foreign lectures are from: Australia, China, Costa Rica, Finland, Germany, Greece, Holland, Iceland, Italy, Japan, Malta, Panama, Poland, Spain, United Kingdom and United States.



Although the program is primarily intended for evening classes, some may be held during working hours, in order to facilitate the participation of faculty members from abroad.

DEHUKAM is open to negotiate cooperation protocols with foreign embassies in Turkey or any foreign institutions on exchanges of foreign students and visiting faculties in support of the Program. Faculties who will deliver courses in the program will be from Turkey as well as foreign countries, with each faculty being a specialist and/or practical expert in its academic field.
